

PROTOCOL
ON
SCIENTIFIC TECHNICAL AND ECONOMIC COOPERATION
BETWEEN
ANKARA UNIVERSITY
AND
TASHKENT STATE ECONOMICS UNIVERSITY

In accordance with the Protocol on cultural and scientific cooperation between the Republic of Uzbekistan and Turkey, and guided by aspiration for strengthening friendship and mutual understanding between two countries and people in the interests of mutually beneficial cooperation of higher schools in the sphere of higher education, science and culture and with the purpose of improvement of effectiveness of professional training and scientific research work in Tashkent State Economics University and Ankara University hereinafter referred to as "sides", decided to conclude this Protocol on cooperation.

I

The Sides will carry out exchange of experience of work, information on pedagogics, methods of teaching, organization and content of higher education, training of highly qualified specialists.

II

On mutual bases the Sides will exchange with publications, teaching and methodical materials, curricula, syllabi, bibliographical and reference books, expositions, prospects and other materials showing the achievements of both higher schools.

III

The Sides express their willingness to carry out joint scientific and research works on actual and mutually interesting problems of science & technics, organization & improvement of training process. The right on the results of mutual work, carried out in the frame of interhigherschool cooperation belongs both sides equally.

IV

The Sides will invite representatives of counter part high school to their most important scientific conferences, symposiums, meetings and other measures connected with the celebration of jubilees, memorable dates which are of great interest to both of them.

V

Within the quota determined by the Plan of cultural and scientific cooperation between the Republic of Uzbekistan and Turkey the Sides will exchange with teachers and scientists to deliver lectures, conduct consultations, joint scientific researches and methodical works, also with postgraduates, practical students and young scientists to improve their qualification and deepen specialization.

VI

The Sides will carry out joint writing of monographs, textbooks, scientific articles, subject collections, organize at the request of other side the editing of articles and monographs, which then will be published by the counterparts. Place of publication will be defined by special working plan of cooperation.

VII

The signed Protocol does not rule out the possibility of conducting other measures in the framework of cooperation between the Sides which may be additionally coordinated then by both sides.

VIII

Concrete measures on cooperation, dates of their conducting, themes of scientific research work and other current problems will be defined by working plans of cooperation for every 2-3 years. For signing working plans Sides will exchange with delegations of plenipotentiaries of higher schools.

IX

Financial conditions of cooperation will be defined by corresponding paragraphs of the Plan of cultural and scientific cooperation between the Republic of Uzbekistan and Turkey. In the event of absence of such paragraphs in the Plan the conditions of exchange will be the following: trips of members of exchanges will be financed by sending side up to the capital of the country of receiving side and back.

Receiving side meets all expenses of participants of exchange during their stay: transport, accommodation, food, set aside funds for every day expenses and if it is necessary provides with medical service/except prosthetic appliance of teeth/, provides with free of charge use of library, necessary conditions for work, organizes the arrival, program of staying and departure of participants of exchange.

Foreign participants of exchange who are coming to the Republic of Uzbekistan for more than two months period will be payed by receiving higher schools in following amounts: doctor of science up to 1400 rubles, candidate of science up to 1300 rubles per month; specialists without scientific degree up to 1200 rubles per month.

Similar salary will be payed by receiving foreign higher school. In other words Ankara University will pay 5.-\$ US pocket money per day (not to exceed 125.-\$ US per month) apart from covering other expenses related to boarding accommodation etc.


The yearly quata of visiting delegations and exchangees are to be determined on the working programmes mutually.

X


The present Protocol comes into effect from the moment of its signing and will be valid within 5 years. Period of Protocol will be automatically prolonged for another 5 years if the Sides would not declare in written form about their intent to stop its action till the six months up to the deadline.

XI

The present protocol is signed in Turkish, Uzbekish and English and two copies of each version. All three versions are equally valid.
